5. What would *you* have said to the woman who ‘wasted’ a whole jar of perfume on Jesus?
6. Was the negative reaction of the people/disciples who were present *really* about caring for the poor? Do you think there were other reasons for their harsh words?
7. Reflect on your own life: has there ever been a time when your ‘outward indignation’ towards others was *actually* about your own ‘inner desires’, agendas, or insecurities? What should we be regularly and humbly asking ourselves regarding our ‘righteous anger’?
